About the Competition

The National Essay Competition on Life Insurance is a nationwide financial literacy initiative designed to educate and inspire school students to understand the importance of life insurance, financial security, and responsible financial planning.

The competition aims to encourage students to think critically about family protection, long-term planning, risk management, and financial decision-making while developing their writing, analytical, and communication skills.

Students from schools across Sri Lanka are invited to participate in this unique national programme.

Enhance financial literacy among school students.



Increase awareness and understanding of life insurance concepts.



Encourage critical and creative thinking.



Promote responsible financial planning from an early age.



Inspire students to become financially responsible future citizens.

Who Can Participate?

The competition is open to students from:

Government School

Private School

International School

Age Categories

Junior Category - 13–16 Years

Students born between 1st January 2010 and 31st December 2013
(Aged 13–16 as of 31st December 2026)

Senior Category - 17–19 Years

Students born between 1st January 2007 and 31st December 2009
(Aged 17–19 as of 31st December 2026)

Competition Languages

Students may write their essays any one of the following languages:

Tamil

English

Sinhala

Competition Format

The competition will be conducted on 22nd August, 2026 as an **in-person examination** at designated examination centres established across all 25 districts of Sri Lanka.

Each participant will be required to write an essay by selecting one topic from three essay topics provided on the day of the examination.

Duration: 1 hour 30 minutes (Maximum)

Participation: Free

The essay should demonstrate:

- Understanding of life insurance concepts
- Ability to apply and analyze knowledge
- Effective communication of ideas

Applicants will receive their examination date, time, and venue details during the **second week of August 2026** via SMS and/or email using the contact details provided during registration.

Applicants are advised to ensure that the mobile number and email address provided are accurate and active.

Essay Topics – Preparation Areas

Students are encouraged to prepare essays on life insurance in relation to:

- A means of providing financial security

Essay Evaluation Criteria

All essays will be evaluated by an independent panel of judges using standardized assessment criteria to ensure a fair, transparent, and impartial evaluation process across all regions.

Evaluation will be based on:

- Relevance to the given topic
- Quality and accuracy of content
- Structure and organization
- Critical thinking and originality
- Language use and clarity of expression
